Gospel of the Kingdom

Mark 1:14-15

Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying,

“The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Gospel of the Kingdom

Mark 1:14-15 (TPT)

Later on, after John the Baptizer was arrested, Jesus went back into the region of Galilee and preached the wonderful gospel of God's kingdom realm. His message was this:

“At last the fulfillment of the age has come! It is time for the realm of God's kingdom to be experienced in its fullness! Turn your lives back to God and put your trust in the hope-filled gospel!”

Gospel of the Kingdom

Repent = metanoéó

Definition: to change one's mind or purpose

Usage: I repent, change my mind, change the inner man (particularly with reference to acceptance of the will of God), repent.

3340 metanoéō (from 3326 /metá, "changed after being with" and 3539 /noiéō, "think") – properly, "think differently after," "after a change of mind"; to repent (literally, "think differently afterwards")

Gospel of the Kingdom

Believe = pisteuó

Definition: to believe, entrust

I believe, have faith in, trust in; pass: I am entrusted with

Matthew 11:4-6

Jesus answered and said to them, “Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the **gospel preached to them**. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me.”

Gospel of the Kingdom

Gospel = euaggelion

(yoo-ang-ghel'-ee-on)

Usage: the good news of the coming of the Messiah, the gospel;

What do we know about the Gospel?

Matthew 24:14

And this **gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world** as a witness to all the nations, and **then the end will come.**

Gospel of the Kingdom

Romans 15:18-20

For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient— **in mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God,** so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I **have fully preached the gospel** of Christ. And so I have made it my aim to **preach the gospel....**

Mark 16:15-20

And He said to them, “Go into all the world and **preach the gospel to every creature**. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.” So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God. And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

Gospel of the Kingdom

Romans 1:16-17

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”

Psalms 22:28

For the kingdom is the Lord's, And He rules over the nations.

Gospel of the Kingdom

Kingdom = basileia

Definition: kingdom, sovereignty, royal power

Usage: kingship, sovereignty, authority, rule, especially of God, both in the world, and in the hearts of men; hence: kingdom, in the concrete sense.

basileía – properly, kingdom; the realm in which a king sovereignly rules. A kingdom always requires a king – as the kingdom of God does with King Jesus! Especially refers to the rule of Christ in believers' hearts

Gospel of the Kingdom

Matthew 10:7-8

And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

Gospel of the Kingdom

Matthew 10:7-8 (TPT)

And as you go, preach this message: 'Heaven's kingdom realm is accessible, close enough to touch.' You must continually bring healing to lepers and to those who are sick, and make it your habit to break off the demonic presence from people, and raise the dead back to life. Freely you have received the power of the kingdom, so freely release it to others.

Gospel of the Kingdom

Luke 10:9-11 (TPT)

Then heal the sick, and tell them all, ‘**God’s kingdom realm has arrived** and is now within your reach!’ But when you enter a city and they do not receive you, say to them publicly, ‘We wipe from our feet the very dust of your streets as a testimony before you! Understand this: **God’s kingdom realm came within your reach** and yet you have rejected God’s invitation!’”

Gospel of the Kingdom

Psalm 145:13

Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom,
And Your dominion endures throughout all
generations.

Daniel 2:44

And in the days of these kings the God of
heaven will set up a kingdom which shall
never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall
not be left to other people; it shall break in
pieces and consume all these kingdoms,
and it shall stand forever.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

Daniel 4:3

How great are His signs, And how mighty
His wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting
kingdom, And His dominion is from
generation to generation

Matthew 4:23

And Jesus went about all Galilee teaching in
their synagogues preaching the gospel of
the kingdom and healing all kinds of
sickness and all kinds of disease among the
people.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

Matthew 11:12

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.

Matthew 12:28

But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

Hebrews 12:28

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

Matthew 16:19

And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

Luke 11:2

So He said to them, “When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your **kingdom come**. Your will be done **On earth as it is in heaven**.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

Romans 14:17

for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 4:20

For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power.

The Gospel of the Kingdom

John 3:2-3

This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, “Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.”

Jesus answered and said to him, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

The Gospel of the Kingdom

John 3:4-6

Nicodemus said to Him, “How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother’s womb and be born?”

Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
